

The Infusion and Immunotherapy Center is **MOVING!** Are you a patient of Valley's Infusion & Immunotherapy <u>Center?</u> Starting Feb. 3, 2025, all appointments will be held in the new space in the East Pavilion building. Here's what you need to know.

ADDRESS: The Infusion & Immunotherapy Center is moving from the main hospital to the East Pavilion building on the main campus. The address is 4009 Talbot Rd. S., Renton.

PARKING: The closest parking is in Parking Garage C. Take the garage elevator to Floor 7. Travel across the Level 7 Bridge of HOPE into Floor 3 of East Pavilion. The new Infusion & Immunotherapy Center will be down the hall to your left, in Suite 310.

DROP OFF: If you are being dropped off for your appointment, it can happen on either side of the building (near the Talbot Professional Center or Parking Lot B). Take the elevator to Floor 3.




