We see children of all ages and all diagnoses, from those with mild speech delays to those with complex, social and medical needs; we provide inpatient and outpatient treatment in occupational therapy (OT), physical therapy (PT), speech and language therapy, social and nutritional services, and family resource connections; Children's Therapy also participates with Valley Medical Center's Neonatal Intensive Care Unit to offer evaluation, treatment, and follow-up for premature and full-term infants experiencing developmental and/or feeding problems; our occupational therapists provide evaluation and treatment to adolescents with mental health issues and suicidal ideation who are hospitalized at VMC; we provide service on the inpatient pediatric unit, supporting the needs of infants to teens; we partner with the Emergency Department related to supporting kids and families with support and supplies, such as Brave Gowns, toys, and virtual reality.

Services/interventions:

Occupational therapy, physical therapy, speech-language therapy, feeding evaluation and treatment, voice lab, pediatric modified barium swallow studies, neonatal intensive care follow-up clinic, rehabilitation programs for sports-related injuries.

Children's Therapy primarily uses play-based activities to build functional skills, while appealing to your child's interests. Therapy is designed to simulate the kinds of surroundings and situations children routinely experience. Your child is unique, so care is individualized: therapists use their expertise and creativity to connect with your child, employing a variety of approaches to help attain his or her full potential in communication, social interaction, mobility, and daily living skills.

Services/interventions:

Hearing aid evaluations and fitting, minimally invasive sinus surgery, novel surgical approaches to the airway, and preoperative assessment of the airway, thyroid and parathyroid surgery. Salivary gland disorders and neoplasms.

Other notes and minimum patient age: Pediatric (all ages) and adult patients are seen. Pediatric OSA/tonsillar hypertrophy/snoring referrals are excluded for these patients: <3yo; <10th percentile or >90th percentile of weight (BMI); craniofacial anomalies (down syndrome, etc.). Please refer those patients to pediatric ENT instead.

Tonsillitis referrals: 7 or more episodes in the past year or more than 5 episodes per year in the past 2 years or more than 3 episodes per year in the past 3 years. Pediatric obstructive sleep apnea confirmed by a sleep study.

Pediatric recurrent ear infection referrals: 3 or more documented/treated ear infections in the past 6 months. Children with bilateral ear infections for 3 months or longer AND documented hearing difficulties. At-risk children (speech, language, learning difficulties) with recurrent ear infections of any duration.

Colorectal cancer; rectal bleeding; anemia; biliary obstruction; acute and chronic liver disease; colon polyps; dysphagia; viral hepatitis; Irritable bowel syndrome (IBS); Inflammatory bowel disease (IBD); including Crohn's disease and ulcerative colitis; diverticulitis, diverticulosis and ischemic bowel disease; celiac disease and food intolerances; heartburn and GERD; chronic vomiting and gastroparesis; functional illness, such as constipation, diarrhea, vomiting, belching and flatulence; peptic ulcer disease and helicobacter pylori; acute and chronic pancreatitis; gallbladder disease; abdominal pain; appendicitis; nutritional deficiencies; obesity; nonalcoholic fatty liver disease; cirrhosis; GI infections caused by viruses, bacteria, fungi and protozoa.

Most infections including but not limited to hepatitis C (HCV), hepatitis B (HBV), HIV, skin and soft tissue infections including chronic wound infections, bone and joint infections, methicillin resistant Staph aureus related infections, chronic lung infections, latent tuberculosis, deep tissue infections, sexually transmitted diseases and Clostridium difficile infections.

Services:

Outpatient antimicrobial therapy, HCV protocol, staph decontamination, HIV care and pre-exposure prophylaxis for HIV.
