Valley's Vaccine Clinic is Now Open **Again for COVID-19 Vaccine and Booster Appointments** Valley Medical



Center's Vaccine Clinic has reopened for COVID-19 vaccines for all people ages 5 and older and boosters for those who are eligible. Please schedule an appointment

through your Valley MyChart account. Don't have a Valley MyChart account? It's free—sign up here. Certain vaccines and boosters are also available in our primary care clinics.

For patients and community members without a MyChart account, COVID-19 vaccines are available at most pharmacies throughout the area, either by walk-in or appointment. Patients can find a vaccine location close to them at the Vaccine Locator website.
