


The Stress Prescription with Dani **Dutro, LMHC**





Childhood vaccination rates have fallen in recent years--now is the best time to get caught up!


Public Health - Seattle & King County is offering nocost vaccination events for children through age 18 throughout South King County for children who:





Be Prepared! Join Us for "Earthquake Preparedness and Shake Alert Early Warning Systems" - Sept. 13, 1 PM


