



When You May Be Required to Mask at Valley this Respiratory Virus Season




Anticoagulation Clinic to Become Medication Management Clinic Beginning Jan. 24, 2024

Medication Management Clinic

UW Medicine VALLEY MEDICAL CENTER Valley's Anticoagulation Clinic's name is changing! Beginning Jan. 24, 2024, the clinic will change its name to the Medication Management Clinic. The name change reflects expanded services offered at the clinic. Current patients of the Anticoagulation Clinic will continue to receive the same service for their anticoagulation therapy.

MEDICAL CENTER The Medication Management Clinic is run by clinical pharmacists. Our pharmacists help patients manage chronic diseases including those treated with anticoagulation medications ("blood thinners") and provide detailed medication teaching. The clinic's goal is to ensure that patients can safely and effectively use their medications. A provider referral is required to become a patient of the Medication Management Clinic.

WHEN: Wednesday, Dec. 20, 9 AM - 3 PM


WHERE: Look for the mobile van parked on the west end of the Medical Arts Center building.
