
Valley Breast Center Team Accredited in Mammography by American College of Radiology




National Disability Employment Awareness Month Events & Resources

The Great ShakeOut is Oct. 19 - Take Time to Make Sure You're Prepared for an Earthquake




October is Earthquake Preparedness Month and includes International ShakeOut Day when millions of people worldwide will participate in earthquake drills at work, school, or home.

This year's <u>Great ShakeOut</u> will be held on Oct. 19. If you're around Valley Medical Center's hospital or clinics on this day you may see staff participating in drills for earthquake preparedness, including a large mass casualty drill around our Emergency Department. 

In recognition of Lung Cancer Awareness Month this November, Valley Medical Center and Vantage Radiology are taking part in <u>National Lung Cancer</u> <u>Screening Day</u> by hosting a low-dose CT lung screening event.

WHAT: Lung Cancer Screening Event WHEN: Saturday, Nov. 11, 7:30 AM - 5 PM WHERE: Valley Medical Center - Olympic Building WHO: Patients who meet the screening criteria, including:

- You are between age 50 and 80.
- You have a 20 pack year smoking history. This means one pack a day for 20 years or two packs a day for 10 years.

• You are a current smoker or have quit within the past 15 years.

Patients will meet with a provider prior to screening to ensure they meet the criteria and to have any questions answered about the procedure.



Correction: New Pulmonary & Sleep Disorder Clinic Hours at Covington North




